Pontiac Township High School District #90 Return to School 2022-2023

Staff will return August 15th. We will run a Freshman Mini-Schedule on August 17th and the entire student body will return on August 18th.

As an overview, the school plan will consist of the following:

- In person classes will be held 5 days a week.
- Masking is optional and those who wish to wear a mask should provide their own, however, masks are available at the Commons entrance and school offices.
- Water “bottle fillers” are available around the school with disposable cups at all bottle filler stations.
- Outside visitors will have very limited access to District #90 property. Visitors are expected to self-certify their health and make an appointment before entering the building whenever possible.
- The school building will be deep-cleaned and disinfected regularly. Each classroom will be equipped with cleaning supplies to spot clean high-traffic areas throughout the day.
- If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, District #90 will work in cooperation with the Livingston County Health Department to determine appropriate measures.

Students should stay home if they have any of the following COVID symptoms:

- Temperature of 100.4F or greater
- Fever, cough, chills, and/or muscle aches
- Shortness of breath and/or persistent headache
- Persistent sore throat, runny nose, and/or loss of taste or smell
- Nausea, vomiting, and or diarrhea

Food Service

District #90 will continue to provide breakfast and lunch with a full menu. The district will provide balanced meals to include meat, meat alternatives, grains, fruits, vegetables, and milk.

- Once students have selected a seat in one of the various spaces, they will be required to sit at that seat for the remainder of the semester unless approved otherwise.
- As always, students may bring their own lunch from home, however food deliveries will not be accepted.

Transportation

Busing will continue to be provided for all qualifying students, with necessary safety modifications in place.

What if my student is required to quarantine?

Remote instruction will be made available for students while they are under quarantine consistent with guidance or requirements from the Livingston County Public Health Department. Students are expected to contact their teachers and let them know they will be out of the building for an extended period of time. Teachers will provide the curriculum electronically through their online learning platform. Regardless of where a student learns, daily attendance will be taken, classes will have firm expectations for learning, and new curriculum will be covered.

Entering the Building

All students must enter through the Commons doors. The Commons doors will be opened at 7:30am every morning. Students are not to attend school if they have any COVID-19 symptoms. If students arrive after 7:55am, they should enter the building through the Main Office doors on the north side of the building.

Leaving the Building

All students must exit the building when the dismissal bell sounds. Students will not be allowed to loiter inside the building or out in front of the Commons. This is being done so school personnel can begin to properly sanitize the school building and teachers can work with students who need additional assistance. Students who violate this policy will be asked to leave.
