

Roger and Joyce Tuttle Scholarship (2020)

Purpose: Roger and Joyce Tuttle have dedicated their lives to the education and advancement of young adults. This scholarship honors their commitment as it assists a young adult in attending college. Any high school senior who plans on attending college, vocational school or technical college is eligible to apply for the scholarship which will be awarded to assist them in their college costs.

Guidelines: Applications are distributed and returned through the Guidance Department of Pontiac Township High School. Applicants are asked to submit completed applications to the Guidance Office on or before April 1, 2020. Applicants may submit photocopies of any transcripts, letters of recommendation or other print materials required for their application.

The Scholarship will be awarded based upon the application, an essay describing how the applicant has been active in leadership in his/her community, and a brief outline of future plans.

Applicants must be seniors who are on track to graduate. Applicants may apply only once, during their final year of high school.

Applicants should have a cumulative 3.0 Grade Point Average (4.0 GPA Scale).

Applicants should have plans to attend college, technical school, vocational school in the Fall, 2020.

The application shall be reviewed by a committee of three persons to include a faculty/staff member of Pontiac Township High School, a representative of First United Methodist Church, and a representative from the Roger and Joyce Tuttle family. Their decision shall be final and confidential.

The Scholarship Check (\$500.00) will be made payable to the applicant and may be used for any college-related costs.

The Scholarship shall be announced at the annual High School Honors Night.

- B. Three letters of recommendation (one should be from a current teacher/staff member at Pontiac Township High School, one should be from a community leader/clergy or person outside the High School who can attest to the applicant's leadership, a third may be from someone at the high school or in the community).**

The letters should note the applicant's leadership roles in school or community. The letters should be collected by the student and presented with the application to the Guidance Office. The letters should be signed by the author. In general, the letters should be 500 words.

- C. Write an essay of no less than 500 and no more than 1,000 words describing your leadership in school, in the community (can include civic affairs, athletics or music, church, Scouting or other clubs). Include a brief description of future plans (what you will be studying in college).**
