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SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROGRAM

In furtherance of the objectives of the Illinois Association of Highway Engineers (IAHE), as stated in its constitution, to advance the professional reputation of the organization and its members and to promote the engineering profession, a scholarship award program has been established.

There are six scholarships available:

1. The IAHE Scholarship is a statewide scholarship offered as a \$2000 grant. This scholarship is available to any U.S. citizen enrolled as a full-time student in a transportation related engineering curriculum at an accredited college or university in the U.S. and has achieved at least junior standing as an undergraduate or a graduate student in his/her first year as of September 1st of this year.
2. The Loftus J. Collamore Memorial Scholarship is a statewide scholarship offered as a \$2000 grant. This scholarship is available only to a member of this association, or a member of the immediate family of a member and enrolled as a full-time student (associate or bachelor) in a transportation related engineering curriculum at an accredited college or university. Applicants must have completed their first year of college as of September 1st of this year to be considered for this scholarship.
3. The State Board Scholarship is a statewide scholarship offered as a \$1000 grant. The scholarship is available only to a member of this association, or his/her immediate family enrolled at any level as a full-time student (associate or bachelor) curriculum at an accredited college or university as of September 1st of this year.
4. The Donald L. Claus Memorial Scholarship is a local chapter scholarship offered as a \$500 grant. This scholarship is available only to a member of this association's local chapter or his/her immediate family or an Ottawa area student enrolled at any level as a full-time student in a transportation related engineering curriculum at an accredited college or university.
5. The Thomas R. Sancken Memorial Scholarship is a local chapter scholarship offered as a \$500 grant. This scholarship is available only to a member of this association's local chapter or his/her immediate family or an Ottawa or Pontiac area student enrolled at any level as a full-time student in a transportation related engineering curriculum at an accredited college or university.

6. The Richard H. Dunavan Memorial Scholarship is a local chapter scholarship offered as a \$500 grant. This scholarship is available only to a member of this association's local chapter or his/her immediate family enrolled at any level as a full-time student in any non-transportation engineering related curriculum at an accredited college or university.

The attached application form should be used to apply for any of the scholarships. If applying for more than one scholarship the same application may be used for all scholarships as long as the proper designation is marked. Only one statewide scholarship will be awarded to the same person in the same year.

Applications shall be made through the local chapters. Each chapter may select one applicant for each of the three statewide scholarships to submit to the State Board IAHE Scholarship Committee for consideration. The local Ottawa Chapter Scholarship Committee will select the recipient of the Donald L. Claus Memorial Scholarship, the Thomas R. Sancken Memorial Scholarship, and the Richard H. Dunavan Memorial Scholarship

Application packets shall consist of:

1. Application
2. School Affidavit Form
3. One-page, typewritten statement by the applicant outlining qualifications, reasons for consideration and career goals
4. High School Transcript (if applicable)
5. Current College Transcript (If applicable)
6. ACT/SAT Test scores (if applicable)
7. Proof of Citizenship (if applicable)

Selection at the Ottawa chapter level and at the IAHE Board level shall be based on the following weighting range, depending on Scholarship applying for:

High School/College Cumulative GPA (If applicable)	30-35%
ACT/SAT Score	0-25%
Applicant Statement	35-50%
School Community Activities	20-30%
IAHE member points	0-5%

Completed applications must be submitted by June 1, 2020 to be considered.

The Ottawa Chapter Scholarship Committee will consider all of the applications received, select the recipient of the Donald L. Claus Memorial Scholarship, Thomas R. Sancken Memorial Scholarship, and the Richard H. Dunavan Memorial Scholarship and select the candidates to be submitted to the IAHE State Board Scholarship Committee for consideration of receiving the IAHE, Loftus J. Collamore Memorial Scholarships and the State Board Scholarship. The State Board Scholarship Committee will consider all the local chapter candidates and make their selections. In case of a tie, the selection will be made by blind drawing from amongst those tied. The selected candidates will be notified in writing and invited to attend the annual meeting of the Association where the awards will be presented. The selected candidate for the Donald L. Claus Memorial Scholarship, Thomas R. Sancken Memorial Scholarship, and the Richard H. Dunavan Memorial Scholarship will receive the award by mail in mid September.

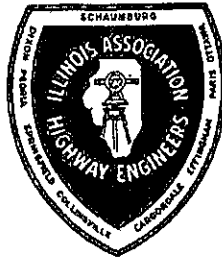
Members of the IAHE Scholarship Committee and the Ottawa Chapter Scholarship Committee and their families shall be ineligible to receive this award during their service year. Previous recipients of the above award are ineligible for applying for the same award a second time.

In case of default of the conditions of this scholarship by the designated recipient thereof, the Scholarship Committee may select an alternate or carry over the award to a subsequent year.
